Stop Genocide in Darfur, Sudan

Over 400,000 people have lost their lives in Darfur since the genocide began. More than 2.5 million people have been displaced, their livelihoods and villages destroyed by government forces and their proxy militias. **Recent reports confirm that the violence continues, and that the security situation is deteriorating.**

Africa Action is engaged in advocacy and activism to stop the genocide in Darfur, Sudan. Although the U.S. government has acknowledged this genocide, it has failed to take the necessary action to protect the people of Darfur. Africa Action's *Campaign to Stop Genocide in Darfur* is calling on the U.S. to seek a UN resolution authorizing a multinational intervention force to support the African Union and protect the people of Darfur.

Government officials who remained silent during the Rwandan genocide often claim that if Americans had clamored for more government action, the U.S. would have had to act, and could have saved hundreds of thousands of lives. **Today, we have a unique power to protect people in Darfur.**
